Have each listener help you complete this form, get your teacher to sign as well, and return the form to the front desk before the deadline. HAVE FUN and prepare for SUCCESS!!!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE MUSIC SPECTATORS:

Please listen to the performance with the following criteria in mind. Then grade the performance on a **scale of 1 – 10** (10 being the highest). Thank you!

- 1. Introduction (walk up from audience area to the side of the room, announce your name and title/composer of your piece, use pretend microphone)
- 2. Walk to performance area
- 3. Pause to prepare, get into the mood of the piece, take on the character of the song
- 4. Use correct posture for your instrument
 - A. Piano bench proper distance, feet on floor or on stool, hands in lap before starting, hands in lap at end before standing
 - B. Guitar If standing use a strap, if sitting: sit on the front edge of the chair, feet on floor or on stool
 - C. Drums check snare, use a fun & engaged facial expression, nod head to beat, stick trick
 - D. Voice use hand held mic, stand with one foot slightly in front of the other, move to 3 different areas of the stage during performance
 - E. Strings stand so audience can see your face, hold instrument at proper height, stand up straight with one foot slightly in front of the other
 - F. Instrumental Stand so audience can see your face, hold instrument at proper height, stand up straight with one foot slightly in front of the other
- 5. Perform from beginning to end, without stopping.
- 6. Conclude performance properly and SMILE
- 7. Move three steps away from performance area to take a DEEP BOW (hold instrument properly)
- 8. Walk back to far end of the room (as if returning to audience seat)
